## NACC PERSON OF THE YEAR



Congratulations to LEL Member Tor Tolleson who was named NACC Person of the Year at their virtual Julebord. The following is an excerpt from the citation by NACC Seattle Chapter President Jahn Hoel.

We have now come to that time that many of you have been waiting for which is the NACC Person of the year Award. This signifies recognition to a person that has provided outstanding service to the Norwegian American community. This years winner is a person that was born in 1945 and raised in Langåker on Karmøy in Norway. After getting his electrical degree at a college in Haugesund, he took off to America pursuing the American dream borrowing NOK 3,000 Norwegian kroner from his grandmother for a plane ticket. He took farewell with his mother and father and arrived in New York in 1965 with \$64.00 in his pocket. From there is journey continued to New Bedford, Massachusetts where he landed his first job with Kaare Ness fishing scallops. He continued working on several vessels before he left for the West Coast hoping to go crab fishing in Alaska.

In 1969 he returned to Norway for the first time after he left with his fiancée Ingrid but did not stay long. They went back to America and he started working for Olav Lunde at Lunde Electric in Ballard. In 1979 he received the prestigious Norwegian Commercial Club Heroism Award after he jumped into heavy dark seas on the stormy night of October 29, 1978 to successfully rescue crewmember Sigmund. He was also awarded the King Neptune Award in 2018 for all his contributions to the Maritime industry by the Norwegian Commercial Club. Throughout the years he has been part owner of several fishing vessels and is a great seaman, fisherman, navigator and boat handler and has worked with and helped several succeed in the fishing industry, among them a guy some of you might know called Kjell Inge Røkke. Today he is an active member of Norwegian organizations such as Karmøy Club, Norwegian Commercial Club, and the National Nordic Museum while he's running his business, Lunde Marine Electronics in Ballard.

He continues to keep business ties with Norway through different projects on Karmoy and tries to make it for the Amerika Fest during the fiskeri dagene each summer.

On the 17th of May he is known for having hotdogs and treats ready for anyone who stops by. Ladies and Gentlemen, it is my true honor to award this year's NACC Person of the Year award to a true gentleman and a friend of mine, Mr. Tor Tollessen!

**Kjartan Ask** died September 24, 2020, at age 92. He joined Leif Erikson Lodge in 1963 and was a Life Member. He was born in Askvoll, in Sogn and Fjordane in Norway. He started working at age 16 and eventually joined the Merchant Marine. In 1953 He came into Los Angeles and immigrated. He came north to Seattle and became a commercial fisherman. He met his wife Joyce, who is from Montana, at a dance at the Norseland-er. They were happily married for 56 years. As well as being a member of the Lodge, he was a member of the Norwegian Commercial Club. He will be missed by his wife Joyce, son Erik and daughter Julie (Mark Hjelle). **Ruth M. Farrens** died December 5, 2020, at age 69. She became a Golden Member of the Lodge in 2018, which she joined in 1978. She was born between Molde and Ålesund in Norway and was a member of the Varnes family, the fifth child born. She came to the United States in 1957. She met her husband Richard and they were married for 30 years. They lived in Sand Point, Alaska for some years before coming down to Washington. She is preceded in death by her parents Margit and Jonas, and brother Bjarne, She is survived by her husband Richard, sister Magni (Hinsee), John (Judy), Ausie (Mike) Hartung, and nephew Chris (Barbie) Varnes. **Bjorn R. Kristoffersen** died November 13, 2020, at age 88. He joined the Sons of Norway in 1972 and transferred to Leif Erikson Lodge in 1980. He became a Golden Member in 2002. He was born in Tromsø, Norway. He married his wife Liv Sandvik in 1953. They first lived in Trondheim and then the United States, where he continued his education, and he graduated from the University of Kentucky with a degree in engineering. He was recruited by Boeing and they moved to Seattle. In the 80's they returned to Norway and he switched from aerospace to oil exploration, first with Mobil, and then with Statoil, before retirement and a permanent return to Seattle. His last years were marked by decline due to Alzheimer's, leaving loved ones with a progressive sense of loss as the disease took its toll. A devoted husband and father known for his kindness and generosity, he will be truly missed. Preceded in death by his wife of 66 years, he is survived by sons Kjartan (Robyn), Steinar (Melissa) and Leif; daughter Berit; 6 grandchildren, 6 great-grandchildren and a younger sister currently living in Sweden.
