Leif Erikson Lodge 2-001, Sons of Norway, Educational Foundation announces the following 2020 scholarships. All completed applications, supporting documents, and recommendations must be received by March 30, 2020, to the Leif Erikson Hall office. Applications are available in the Leif Erikson Hall office, Monday through Friday from 10AM-3PM.

\*Camp Normanna or Camp Nidaros Endowed LEL Scholarship Award with the Youth Camp Program for District 2, Sons of Norway, provides the recipient with a scholarship for 25% of the fee for the camps. Camp Normanna is near Everett, Washington, and Camp Nidaros is near Seaside, Oregon.

\*Camp Trollhaugen Endowed LEL Scholarship Award with the Youth Camp Program for District 2, Sons of Norway, provides the recipient with a scholarship for 25% to the fee for the camp. \*Douglas Warne Vocational Scholarship is funded from an endowment established by Past President of Leif Erikson Lodge 2-001, Douglas Warne. An award is given to an eligible person who is a least a senior in high school--25 years old attending or planning on attending an accredited technical, trade, or vocational program in Washington State. The amount of the award for 2020 is a minimum of \$1,500.

\*Queen/King and Princess/Prince Scholarship Program awards two young people who represent the lodge as its Royalty an award of \$1000 or \$400 respectively. The winners will represent Leif Erikson Lodge 2-001, Sons of Norway, in at least five events of their choosing during the year.

\*Youth Camp Instructor/Counselor Grant for persons who can provide a positive camp experience for young people participating in the District Two Sons of Norway Youth Camp Program. There is \$500 award check per camp with preference being given to applicants participating in at least two camps.

\*Youth Leadership Award is for one young person planning on attending an institution of higher learning or trade school. The amount of the award is \$1,000.

### REMEMBERING KNUT EINARSEN

Long time LEL member, Knut Einarsen, will be a part of an upcoming temporary exhibit at the National Nordic Museum, entitled "Why We Collect: New Acquisitions from the National Nordic Museum. It will include information about Knut, as well as other notable people. It will be open to the public from March 5 – July 19, 2020. Knut passed away on January 18, 2019 at the age of 104. Knut and his family immigrated to the US and to Ballard in 1948. On Oct. 28. 1964 Knut and Haldis joined Leif Erikson Lodge and eventually became a life member of Sons of Norway. Knut was also one of the lodge members who helped build our lodge building in Ballard back in the 1980's. He and wife Haldis fled from the Nazis in occupied Norway in 1943, skking and walking to Sweden. Knut was a member of the Norwegian resistance, and even after immigrating to America, he went back to Norway to guide refugees to Sweden. Knut contributed over 1,000 hours to the construction of our beautiful lodge. Knut and Haldis were also longtime Volunteers at the Lodge Kaffestua. The National Nordic Museum boasts a permanent collection of over 80,000 objects, a number that grows thanks to the generosity of its donors. However, all potential acquisitions must meet a rigid set of criteria and answer the following questions in the affirmative: Is it a candidate for display and research? Is it in exemplary condition? Is it relevant to the Museum's mission and core values? This exhibition poses this last question and illustrates possible responses through objects recently acquired. See new additions to the permanent collection of fine and decorative artworks, archival materials, and archaeological finds.
